Overview:

In a continuing effort to provide security, prosperity, and values of the American people worldwide the Department of State solicited the need to upgrade its Embassy security systems worldwide. The Department of State wanted the following activities to be maintained in a cost effective manner.

- Protect vital interests, secure peace, deter aggression, prevent and defuse crises, halt the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction, and advance arms control and disarmament.
- Expand exports, open markets, maintain global growth and stability, and promote economic development.

SMF provided the solution

In December 1999 the Department of State requested the services of Brown& Root to perform worldwide upgrades of U.S. Embassy’s. The Brown & Root team looked for SMF to provide the equipment and services needed for the worldwide embassy upgrade.
